



2020-2021 Spouse Income Information

Your spouse's 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that before awarding Federal Student Aid, you may be asked to confirm the information reported on your spouse's FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information the financial aid administrator at their school will compare their FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your spouse's FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid administrator at your spouse's school. Their school may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact the financial aid administrator as soon as possible so that your spouse's financial aid will not be delayed.
