Philanthropy is a crucial resource enabling the College of The Albemarle to carry out its mission and achieve its goals. Recognizing this, the Board of Trustees understands the importance of the President taking a leadership role in securing gift support for the College and coordinating all of the College's development efforts to respect current and prospective donors.

The College complies with accreditation expectations of SACSCOC Standard 5.2.c in that the president has ultimate responsibility for and exercises appropriate control over the college's fund-raising activities.

Thus, no fundraising shall be undertaken on behalf of the College by faculty or staff without the express consent of the President or the President's designated representative, or the Executive Director of the College of Albemarle Foundation.

All fundraising efforts by student organizations shall be approved in advance by the Vice President for Student Success and Enrollment Management in consultation with the Executive Director of the College of Albemarle Foundation.
