Credits for Prior Learning

Division of Responsibility: Learning; Student Success and Enrollment Management

The purpose of a prerequisite and/or a corequisite is to ensure student success in subsequent coursework. While successful completion of prerequisites and/ or corequisites is the traditional way students demonstrate readiness, in exceptional circumstances students may demonstrate readiness through other means. In such cases, state prerequisites or corequisites may be met through other means, including the credit for prior learning methods with appropriate documentation and approval from the vice president of learning. Local prerequisites or corequisites may be met through other means, including the credit for prior learning methods with appropriate documentation and approval from the appropriate academic dean. Documentation of the approval will be maintained on file.
